### Volunteer Role - Community Fundraiser

<b>WHERE</b>	Across the county and/or in your local community. Occasional visits to the office may be required, which is based at The Red House, 119 Fore Street, Hertford, SG14 1AX. Office hours are Monday to Thursday 9.00am to 5.30pm Friday 9.00am to 4.30pm.
<b>WHEN</b>	You can support or organise Fundraising Events at any time during the week including evenings and weekends. This will be driven by you. Ideally we would like a volunteer who is able to be flexible with their time.
<b>ROLE</b>	Carers in Hertfordshire is looking for enthusiastic individuals who can promote Carers in Hertfordshire as a charity and can coordinate fundraising in their community. The role tasks/responsibilities are to organise/attend fundraising events and to be a link between the other fundraisers in the community (both corporate organisations and individuals), to liaise with the Fundraising Manager Linda Cudmore and to develop future fundraising opportunities.
